



Salers Foundation 2010 Scholarship Program Guidelines and Application

The American Salers Foundation will award a scholarship annually to a member of the American Salers Junior Association. The winner will be announced during the American Salers Annual Meeting and Banquet held in conjunction with the National Western Stock Show.

Eligibility:

The applicant must be a member in good standing of the American Salers Junior Association (ASJA); and have been a member of the ASJA for at least two years. Scholarship funds are to be used for furthering the recipient's education in the field of their choice. Applicants must be at least a high school senior, as funds are for post-secondary education.

Funds:

Two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.

One memorial scholarship in the amount of \$250.

These scholarships will be paid directly to the recipient for funding of fees at their post-secondary institution.

Selection:

The scholarship committee will evaluate all applicants and make their decision based on the merits of the application. Selection will be based on academic record, activities and Salers cattle involvement. Applicants should demonstrate leadership experience, be active in ASJA activities and breed promotion.

Application:

The Foundation Scholarship application follows on the second page. The completed application must be accompanied by a current transcript and picture.

Deadline:

All applications and materials must be postmarked no later than December 1, 2009.
